## **What's New At Dyed In The Wool**

We received a really nice box from Illimani Yarn filled with some Sabri which I used for the Baubles Shawl by Andrea Mowry. This is a blend of Alpaca and Cotton and an absolute dream to knit with. I used two skeins of cream, and one skein each of camel and gray. The Baubles Shawl will be a class during the summer months so don't wait too long to get the colors of Sabri that you are going to need.

Also in this box was Amelie in light gray and cream. We used this to knit the Hillview Road Cowl by Holli Adams Samet and the Jacob's Ladder Seaman's Scarf by Jennifer Hoel. The Hillview Road used one skein with two skeins required for the Jacob's Ladder. These are two patterns that we came up with.....what patterns will you find?

## **Rowan Afternoon**

We had a wonderful day with Michael, our Rowan Rep. The magazine and books from Rowan were so much fun, so many great designs it was hard to pick which one to knit first. The other feature that Rowan added was that, with the exception of the Magazine, all the patterns from books are available in book form or can be purchased individually through Ravelry's In Store Program.

## **What's On Our Needles**

Lynda is making the sweetest little cardigan for Amelia for Easter. The pattern by Anne B Hanssen is simple but very attractive and is knitting up really nicely in the Baby Bamboo. The Old Shale Cardigan is part of the In Store Ravelry Program. There are two patterns available, the first is from 3 months to 18 months and the Big Girls option runs from 2 to 6 years.

I have been working the Minimal Sweater from the cover of Rowan Magazine 65. I chose the Ecrú for this but there were so many fabulous colors to choose from. Mapping this pattern made the knitting so easy. Cotton may not be my preferred fiber to knit with but the Cotton Glace felt really good in my hands. There are also a couple of surprise projects that I am working on for LYS Day using Valley Tweed, Kid Silk Haze, Cotton Patine and one of the Vegan Lace yarns.

## **Knit, Spin, Weave or Crochet**

## **Butterfly or Papillon Shawl**
