and have worked it against a LaJolla for body. Really happy with the results.

On Small Business Saturday there will be some fun groupings of colors for the Hitch on the Move by Martina Behm.

A few color bundles for a new scarf that I have designed that is suitable for a beginner and very relaxing for an experienced knitter using the wonderful Alpaca Classic.

There will be a new pattern for Sequoia which is the softest chunky yarn I have worked with and the colors, well, what can I say it is made by Mira at Baah.

Berroco is offering two new hat patterns in Vintage, one in crochet and the other is knitted. Samples are already made and I really like them and I don't wear hats! They worked up really quickly in both knit and crochet and were a lot of fun to make.

There will be a new pattern for the large squishy ball of Orion that everyone wants to touch. It knits up on a size 9 needle and has lots of texture and also can be blocked with or without soft pleats. I like the way the texture breaks up the colors without dulling them down.

Christmas Surprise(s)

I will be creating a few patterns for the Christmas Surprise this year. I am putting the finishing touches on the patterns and checking my yarn choices. The projects will be available for sign up on the 5th of December.
