In anticipation of the yarn we will be hosting a **Trunk Show** featuring this fabulous yarn beginning **February 21st through the 25th**. Please stop in and see these garments, we are sure that you will like them as much as we do.

I am also knitting Rum & Cola with a larger yarn than it calls for with a 6mm bead. I hope to have them finished to share with you very soon.

Lynda is currently knitting the Gansey socks also as well as an unusually colored sock from Baah. I also know that she is honing her spinning skills too!
