What's New At Dyed In The Wool

Quiet a few boxes have been arriving. We have several from Rowan filled with all the colors of Spring. We have received their Cotton Glace, some amazing new colors of Cotton Cashmere, a new yarn called Denim Revive. The Denim Revive is recycled and gives a very beautiful tweedy effect. The Moordale is wonderfully British in rich colors.

Another box that you might be interested in arrived from Lorna's Laces. It was filled with an amazing collection of colors in Shepherd Worsted. This yarn is perfect for babies and children, it is so soft and of course machine washable. We have new colors of Solemate which is perfect for socks.

A new yarn for us is the Mrs. Crosby yarn called Satchel. This yarn is considered a sport but it will knit up as a fingering weight yarn. It is a delightfully soft single ply that will drape very well and the colors are amazing.

Another new yarn is Perennial from Kelbourne Woolens. It is composed of 60% superwash merino, 25% suri alpaca and 15% nylon. There are 497 yards to a skein of 100 grams. I have already chosen a color to make a second pair of Horizon Socks as this will knit up beautifully at a gauge of 9sts per inch.

We will try again to host our Rowan Get Acquainted Day on the 13th of March unless the weather intervenes, again! Come in, bring your needles as we will have sample balls to play with as well as a few other surprises.

What's On Our Needles

Lynda is currently knitting a shawl using a combination of yarn she dyed along with some of her leftover sock yarn. I am so looking forward to seeing this finished as the colors are just dancing along her needles and look so beautiful together.

I also think that she might be sharing a little Easter Surprise for you too! She is one to keep an eye on as you never know what she is going to get up to.

I was able to complete my Up Market Bag in Daisy from Knit 1, Crochet Too. I also finished the Young, Scrappy & Cozy Cowl in Fibre Company's Acadia. Kelly asked for help in choosing yarn for Stephen West's Boneyard Shawl and well, I found some that I liked so I knitted the Boneyard Shawl too. I currently have Secrets & Storms on my needles by Helen Kennedy in two skeins of LaJolla.

Mayfield Scarf
