I am really excited about the new products that have come in from BAM Fiberworks. We have hackles and combs and my favorite thing about them is their magnetic covers. We also have dizzes (I am sorry but I don't know the correct word for multiple diz). This makes these rather dangerous tools a lot safer. I also have been playing with the Fainting Maid, which is a wool picker that has helped me turn some freshly washed fleece into boxes of fluff ready to be carded. I have these wonderful tools set up in the Spinning and Weaving Center if you would like to try them. The hackles and combs come in fine and extra fine.

Our basket of Sequoia is filled but I am sure that it won't be for long.

There are some wonderful semi solid colors of Shasta that came in the mystery box along with some skeins of La Jolla that have been dyed with intentional pooling. There are many wonderful patterns out there on Ravelry right now including "Pooling by the Pool" and

"Enchanting Elegance". Dawn Barker also has some wonderful patterns for this type of yarn.

From Urth Yarns we have the super soft and lovely yarn called 16. This is a wonderful fingering/sport weight yarn that comes in some truly gorgeous shades. The neutral shades are my favorite but so are the greens, pinks, blues, purples and reds. So many colors.....so little time!

Also from Urth is a fabulous yarn called Spiral Grain with so many colors in each skein. This is also a heavy fingering, light sport that will work perfectly as an accent for 16.

Another lovely highly colored yarn with a complimentary solid is Marla and Sami from Manos. This is a lovely, squishy yarn that knits like a worsted. I made a shawl with this yarn but Kathleen created a wonderful cowl from one of Manos free patterns.
