The colors are different than in previous years except for the Whistlestop which is the color that the sample is made in, however, it has come in a deeper shade and is quite beautiful in a darker sort of way!

In the same box as the Cush we also received a new color of Aerie. The new color is a brilliant red and we also received that beautiful green that was so popular. Aerie was one of the choices for last year's Christmas Surprise.

Also in the same box as more Breathless which is a squishy sock weight that has a little cashmere in it. Great for Cowls, Socks, Scarves, Shawls, Fingerless Gloves.....well you get the idea - it's versatile and gorgeous.

Amelie is a new yarn and is an Aran weight so it is a little heavier than a worsted but not quite a chunky. It weighs absolutely nothing and flows through your hands like silk. Fiber content is an amazing blend of silk, alpaca and merino. You must touch this yarn to enjoy the touch and see the luminosity for yourselves.
