From West Yorkshire we have a beautifully colorful basket of Wensleydale and sparkling jewel tones in Exquisite. Exquisite is a spectacular blend of Falkland Wool and Silk in jewel tones and a few softer tones. Wensleydale is a wool yarn that is exceptionally light with a softer haze than a mohair. I am planning to use Exquisite for the Boo MKAL called Apparition.

We have added a wonderful superwash worsted wool from Berroco with a super pattern book. For children we have Rascals from Sirdar. Also from Sirdar we have the very colorful Colourwheel.

We have new colors in the following yarns: Titus and Dovestone; Glem Lace, Road to China Light; Cumbria and Cumbria Light as well as Sirdar's Snuggly Baby Bamboo.

The Arranmore Light has been put on the shelves and we hope to be shelving the latest yarn from Rowan, Valley Tweed very shortly.

New or Notable

We have been scanning Revelry and noticed how the Hitchhiker Beyond by Martina Behm is always near the top of the most popular patterns. So, Lynda knitted the Hitchhiker Beyond in Kettle Tweed and it is truly beautiful. I really like the little flecks of tweed that pop out. A fun knit and so very wearable. This would make a great gift for someone knitworthy.

I tried several yarns when I decided to knit the Paris Toujours by Isabell Kraemer. I fell head over heels in love with the Wensleydale. This pattern was a delight to knit and of course I had to make a cheat sheet. This would also make a great gift for someone very dear to you.
