Baby Dream has just arrived from Rico. This is one of the softest dk yarns you could ever touch. It had me fooled, I thought it was a merino with a tiny bit of cashmere but it is really 50% acrylic and 50% polyamide. Washes like a dream too!

Also from Rico is Fashion Alpaca Superfine Heavens. This cloud of a yarn is going to knit up like a chunky at 12sts over 4" and is super soft with soft and subtle color ways.

From Universal Yarn there is a delightful blend of 70% baby alpaca and 30% extra fine merino wool which will knit up to a dk weight and comes in gorgeous natural shades.

The color that we did not have in stock for the Plied Trunk Show is now in the shop. This is a gorgeous mix of pink and a deep blue. The sample was Stephen West's Dotted Rays. There is a limited supply of this color available.

June Cashmere fingering is now in stock and I have made two pairs of wristers can't wait to make something else in this amazingly soft yarn. I am trying to pull together an event so that we can learn about the cashmere
