Amble is the latest yarn from Daphne at The Fibre Company. I know that this yarn has been in development for a long time and it is so worth the wait. I see some Golden Pear Socks in my future.

From Rowan we have a superb collection of designs for this Spring and Summer using many of our favorite yarns like, Creative Linen, Summerlite, both DK and 4 Ply, Cotton Glace, Denim Revive and of course many others including Kid Silk Haze.

Magazine 69 features two wonderful sections, one called Nostalgia and the other is called Cotton Classics by Martin Storey. My favorite is the Cotton Classics all made with SoftYak DK and many feature fabulous cables.

Mode Collection Four is just one amazing pattern after another. I didn't know what to make first so I knitted Dijon and Summer White.

Ease is a collection of 18 designs by Lisa Richardson and I found it hard to pick a favorite. These designs are for wearing now and always. They are classics with an edge and I really was excited by this years collection.

## Ravelry Unraveled
