What's New At Dyed In The Wool

We are really excited to announce that our next shipment from Dream in Color has shipped and should be on our shelves soon.

Our summer pattern books from Rowan are amazing. Lovely beachy summer colors in relaxed designs. I especially love the long vests and oversized cover ups. Another great season for Rowan.

There are new shades of Denim Revive, a salmon pink, a gorgeous gold and an amazing grass green. A perfect addition to the many colors we already have in stock.

Fine Lace has gotten very bold this season with a strong navy, a perfect pink, a luscious lime and an outrageous orange. Most of you know that I am not a big fan of orange but I love this one.

Lynda and I have fallen in love with the original Island Blend and now we have another yarn to fawn over: the sensational Island Blend Fine. This is a fingering weight version of the Island Blend we love with 70% merino, 15% alpaca and 15% silk. So many fun colors to choose from which are bolder than the original Island Blend. We have found that the original Island Blend is a perfect yarn for Chemo Caps.

Our Berroco Summer Silk has arrived. This wonderfully soft yarn knits up at 5.5sts per inch on a 4.5mm or US size 7 needle. The combination of

45% silk, 43% cotton and 12% nylon makes for a deliciously soft fabric when knitted. The colors are soft but strong. I particularly like the camel which would look wonderful when paired with the cream and just a touch of the softest pink.

Berroco's other new yarn for us is called Mantra and we also have Mantra Stonewash. The colors are bolder than the Summer Silk with a stunning red as well as a soft gray and pretty pink. This DK weight yarn knits up beautifully on a US 6 or 4mm needle also giving us 5.5sts per inch. This is a 100% silk product with a smooth, matte finish. The Stonewash has a slightly marbled appearance.

Both these new yarns will be fabulous for summer shawls and shells.
