Arne & Carlos also have a new sock line coming out. Two of the four colors are on their way with two more to follow.

There will be new colors of Moordale, Cotton Cashmere and Alpaca Soft arriving very soon. Kaffe Fassett has also developed a new line of colors for Felted Tweed. There are gorgeous velvety greens, soft satin pinks, perfect peaches. This line is rich with saturated colors.

Our Rowan Launch could not have gone better. We sold out of the My London book by Georgia Farrell on the first day. Magazine 68 has sold out, as did Carousel and we are anxiously awaiting these books coming back into stock. In the meantime I have a waiting list for all of the books.
